

SMS SOURCES FOR SMS SERVICE IN SMS TERMINAL

SMS Terminal supports two types of SMS sources. The switching is performed by selecting one of two available modes **External Exchange** or **Text Messages** from the pop-up list located in the Settings Tab of SMS Terminal.

1) **External Exchange** mode is based on using SMS Harvester software. This is special program that maintains Internet connection and collects sms messages from various links of .htm, .php format. It can also read usual .txt files of special format demonstrated below.

.txt format supported by SMS Harvester:

Index1 Message1_text

Index2 Message2_text

Index3 Message3_text

...

end

where

Index is unique ID of SMS message,

Message_text is the text of the message,

SPACE separates the index from the message text;

In order to specify the files with SMS messages for SMS Harvester one needs to set the path to the folder with these files in **SMS** field of Settings Tab in SMS Terminal. Right after reading of the particular file the program deletes it. If there are several files are copied to the folder simultaneously then the order of reading files is determined by its creation dates.

.htm, .php format supported SMS Harvester:

The link provided to SMS Harvester to get SMS messages should refer to the page that displays SMS messages in the same format that is used for messages in txt files.

2) Text Messages mode allows you to display SMS messages from .txt files in the particular folder specified in Settings Tab of SMS Terminal (**Path to the Messages** field). Every new line in .txt file is detected by program as a separate SMS message.
